Prohibited Schemes like Pyramid Structures come your way in different forms.

They not only deceive you, but they ruin your family's happiness and relief too! Take the better and safer options & save your hard-earned money!

Basic Features of Prohibited Schemes like Pyramid Structures include

- A higher return is promised either when number of participants increase or contribution increases.
- · Often makes false promises about exceptionally high returns and other benefits.
- Products offered through the scheme do not have a strong market demand and often do not have a secondary market.
- Guarantees or after sales services are not provided for the products.
- Return from the scheme varies with the number of new recruits brought in by a participant, but not with his/her sales volume.
- · Entry fee is often high.
- · No Buy-back Policy for remaining unsold products, when a participant quits the scheme.
- · Focus on selling product is very little and the main motive is to recruit more new participants.
- Hastily recruits new participants providing lucrative deals and make sure that the time is insufficient for the participant to think twice.
- Usually, the offer to join comes as an easy job which requires little or no experience or qualifications.
- Generally, it is a trusted friend or a family member that tries to recruit you, since it is very hard to resist the offer.
- Information about the scheme, its whereabouts, contact details etc. are generally unaccessible.

Note: It is illegal to both initiate and participate in prohibited schemes like Pyramid Structures.

If found guilty of such an offence, a person is subject to rigorous imprisonment and/or a fine.
